FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is covered by the surcharge payment?

The surcharge payment helps to cover the cost of the breakfast program and schoolwide shabbatonim, mishmar (YOC only), and certain trips and programs. The surcharge for Yeshivat Or Chaim is \$1,850, and for Ulpanat Orot is \$1,450 and is debited on June 12, 2026.

What is the Late Fee?

Parents who do not submit their contract, deposit, and payment method on time are subject to a \$300 late fee. The fee will be assessed for any registration received after February 27, 2026 and will be added to the deposit payment.

What is the process for financial assistance?

Tuition assistance is available through the UJA's platform (link to their site) for any parent who requires financial aid. There are

two different sources of scholarship available, the Day School Subsidy and the Generations Trust program. Please refer to the [calculator](#) to determine which application best suits your needs. Scholarship applications are open and are due on Feb 27, 2026. Only families that registered their children will be considered. Late or incomplete applications may result in a delay or fewer subsidy dollars available. Subsidy must be agreed upon, and a payment plan must be in place to receive admit-to-class card.

What is the Technology Fee?

The \$325 technology fee represents the annual cost to students toward the equipment that the school provides to each student to ascertain that the students have compatible equipment for

the school's apps and technological framework. Parents can pay this fee on June 12, 2026 with the surcharge, or it can be added into the tuition payments. For the 26/27 school year, this fee will be charged to students entering grades 9 and 10.

What is the Security Fee?

A security guard is posted at each school to better protect our students in the face of the rise in antisemitism and hate crimes in the GTA. The \$100 fee per student covers some of the costs associated with the security guard. Parents can pay this fee on June 12, 2026 with the surcharge, or it can be added into the tuition payments.

What other costs may arise?

In addition to the tuition and additional fees stated above, parents are responsible for the costs of books and school supplies, fees associated with co-curricular activities and elective courses and programs (such as tournaments and Model UN) and graduation-related fees (for Grade 12). There is an athletic fee associated with each sport team that covers the costs of running a specific seasons/tournamnets. Fees will vary by sport.

What is the Learning Hub?

Each campus has a learning hub staffed by skilled learning strategists. Students are welcome to use the hub as a quiet space to work and complete assessments. Our strategists are also available for tutoring during the school day (for a fee) to work one on one with students for either curriculum- or subject-specific tutoring or executive functions support. Students may be recommended to the Learning Hub by the Director of Educational Support or parents can be in touch to discuss the various options. It is a multi-tiered system whereby a specific level of support is suggested for any student who requires academic aid. Families will be invoiced pursuant to the agreement made with the

Learning Hub. This program was built to facilitate access to support within the school environment so that families do not need to outsource support outside of school hours.

What methods of payment are available?

Payors may select to pay tuition by Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) or by credit card. Tuition for those who select to pay by credit card will be \$29,675. If the payor opts to pay by PAD, tuition will be discounted to \$28,800.

Any payments to the school by cheque should be payable to Bnei Akiva Schools. If alternate arrangements are required, prior approval by the business office is required.

What is the financial policy for withdrawing a student?

Tuition for the month of withdrawal remains payable in full and will not be refunded. Any prepaid tuition for the following months will be refunded.

How do I change my payment plan?

Any changes in the payment plan must be approved by the business office. Changes to PAD forms or credit card information must be made with 30 days' written notice.

What is the policy for returned (bounced) payments?

Returned payments must be replaced within one business week in the form of a bank draft. A \$25 NSF fee is to be paid in addition to the returned funds.
